

Elegant Harp Music for *Weddings* and *Special Occasions*

Music is the "finishing touch" to all weddings. Harp music is romantic, graceful, and elegant. It can be tailored to accommodate all aspects of the wedding, and reception. Live music is the personal touch which reflects the bride and groom's attention to the final detail to make the wedding day memorable and special. It brings the ceremony together by setting the atmosphere as the guests are arriving and being seated. Music adds the grandeur to the processional, time for reflection during the wedding, and adds the sparkle to the wedding.



Wedding Ceremonies are priced by the ceremony and include any or all of the following:

- 30-Minute Prelude
- Processional, Recessional
- 15-Minute Postlude
- Special Music during the Ceremony
- Accompany Soloists and Instrumentalists

Receptions, dinners, rehearsals, etc., are priced by the hour. Special pricing is available when using the harp for the ceremony and reception.

Protocol for Harp Services

Remember that you will need to select music for one or all of the following: the rehearsal dinner, the wedding ceremony, the cocktail hour and the reception.

When selecting music for your ceremony talk to your officiant. They may have guidelines about music that is appropriate for their facilities.

Set aside a time when we can meet--whether on the phone, email or in person. Decide what type of music you would like for your ceremony, and reception. I encourage specific requests and I will also make recommendations. My studio is available for personal consultation. Music selections are also available on my website.

For outside weddings the harp needs a **dry, shaded** location with a flat surface. Remember to make alternate plans for inclement weather. The harp **must remain** in an enclosed shelter in the event of rain (even sprinkles and mist).

A signed contract and deposit will reserve your wedding day on my engagement calendar.
